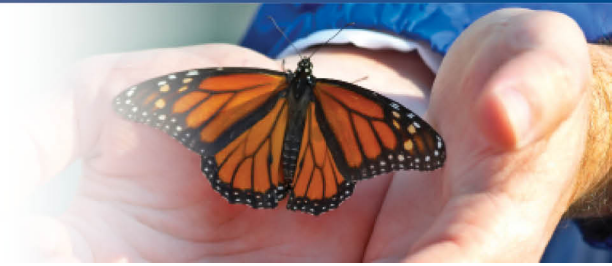

## Homeless Outreach

Trained staff travel to places in the community in which homeless individuals frequent such as Marion House Soup Kitchen, Salvation Army and New Hope Shelter.

### Overview:

Community outreach provided to homeless individuals in settings such as Marion House Soup Kitchen, Salvation Army and New Hope Shelter. The goal of homeless outreach is to connect homeless individuals who suffer with mental health and substance abuse problems with appropriate behavioral health services.

Client criteria for program: 1) Individual age 18 or older; 2) Homeless; and 3) Diagnosable mental illness.
